

USE OF SIGÉOM SYMBOLOGY




SIGÉOM represents Quebec's geomining information through a library of symbols, colour combinations, rendering rules and mapping elements that enable the user to make better use of the data. This sheet illustrates the different methods of using SIGÉOM symbology depending on the GIS platform used.

ESRI Platform:

SIGÉOM fonts in the « Fonts » folder should be copied to your station in the C:\Windows\Fonts folder or any other folder containing Windows fonts. In addition, the « SIGEOM.style » symbol

library must be copied to your station for use in ArcGIS solution with the « Apply Style functionality ».

For the use of shapefiles (shp) or entity classes (FGDB), the "SIGEOM.style" library must be attached to the layer's properties and the « Symbolization Code » field must be specified.



QGIS Platform:

Extension files .sld contained in the _Symbolization folder may be attached to layers of geological zones, geological subdivisions, and morpho-sedimentological zones for both a shapefile (shp), an entity class (FGDB) or a geopackage layer (GPKG) in QGIS.
