Dear Sirs:

Please find enclosed Report on Operations of Bevcourt Gold Mines Limited for the month of December 1953.

Production - Production for the month totalled 22,305 tons grading 0.130 cz. per ton as compared with 19,652 tons grading 0.128 cz. in November.

Costs - While the total operating cost was higher due to year-end adjustments, the cost per ton milled was the same as in the previous month at #4.07 due to the greater tonnage milled.

Profit - The operating profit for December of \$14,364.29 showed an improvement over the previous months' figure of \$12,629.78 mainly due to the greater tonnage milled.

General - While work under construction actually decreased, capital expenditures showed an increase over November's figure due to the late arrival of some invoices for materials used and equipment assembled in previous months. Also included is the invoice for \$4706.10 for the new 200 H.P. Motor for the Symons Cone Crusher ordered last June but which only arrived at the end of December.

Construction work is now rapidly drawing to a close allowing a lay off of 14 men this week. As the surface men are reduced more miners will be taken on to speed up the underground development and preparation of new stopes. In this connection the cross-cut on the bottom level at 1600' will be started in the first week of February.

On behalf of the Company, I wish to express our sorrow at the passing of our President, Col. R. M. Courtney, on January 1st.

Dear Sirs:

A summary of operations for the month of December 1953 is as follows:-

Production & Costs - A total of 22,305 tons of ore was milled for an average of 719.5 tons per day. Net income including \$17,371.59 estimated E.G.M.A. was \$105,202.75. Operating costs including \$2181.93 interest on loans was \$90,838.46. Operating profit, therefore, was \$14,364.29.

Operating costs were higher than normal mainly due to administrative costs which showed an increase of \$4945.56 over that in November. The increase was due to Christmas Gifts (Turkeys and cigarettes), Audit expense, and year-end adjustments.

The following report is a compilation of the records as of December 31st, 1953, before any adjustments by Auditors.

Buildings - Repair work on the Duplex building was completed sufficiently to allow two families to move into it. Pouring of the concrete floor in the basement of this building remains to be done at a later date. Repair work and the pouring of the concrete floor was completed in the fourth residence.

The Curling Rink was moved from Perron to Bevcourt in three sections at the expense of the Curling Club.

The Steel and Electric Shop was completed and re-occupied. Drain pipes, track, and turntable were laid and concrete floor poured.

Work continued on the new heating plant and is now nearing completion. The Shavings bin was completed and inclined ramp to it about 50% completed. The new Boiler house 37' wide by 62' long by 15' high was completed with concrete block walls and insulated corrugated iron roof. This new building was constructed around the old boiler house and the old building was then demolished. The HRT Boiler from Perron was brought in and erected on four steel columns on a concrete mat. The steel frame was assembled around it and laying of bricks and plibrico completed. The erection of the smoke stack 66 feet high was also completed.

Steam heating was extended to the Machine Shop, Steel & Electric Shop, Warehouse, and Curling Rink.

Mill -Improvements in the mill continued with change over to tertiary classification and two stage thickening completed in January.

Mine - On the 700' level, long hole drilling of the top sill of 801 pillar was completed and blasted. This sill is now ready for vertical long hole drilling.

On the 800 level, long hole drilling of the top sill of 905 zone stope was completed in January and partly blasted.

On the 1150' level, 1103-2 and 1103-3 stopes have been mainly completed to the porphyry contact. Two new stopes, however, 1103-1 and 1103-7 will replace them on the same north-dipping vein. Two other stopes on south-dipping veins are currently providing mill feed.

The east drift was slashed out ten feet to the north to expose a narrow high grade southdipping vein indicated by diamond drilling and drifting is now proceeding along this vein.

On the 1300' level, the south-dipping vein followed in 1303 west drift narrowed to two inches against a shear zone. Continuation of this vein on the other side of the shear, however, is expected as diamond drilling one hundred feet to the west indicated that it is there. Drifting to the west is to be continued in February. In the meantime, stoping on this narrow vein has produced a small tonnage of high grade mill feed.

On the east side of the 1300' level the zone intersected in hole 868 averaging 0.159 cunces over 27.5 feet has been reached and is presently being developed with two sublevels. This zone is a bleached, tourmalinized, and fractured granodiorite with slight pyrite mineralization and quite different from the usual vein or combination of veins and stringers. The average cut grade to-date from the sublevel muck samples is 0.13 ounces.

On the 1450' level the west drift advanced 208 feet on line to 316 feet west of the main cross-cut. Diamond drilling from this drift is now in progress. The east drift was turned north east for 53 feet to investigate a shear with tails of quartz, indicated by drilling. This zone which averaged 0.15 ounces pinched out after 35 feet so the drift was again driven on line and advanced a further 93 feet with 60 feet now to go to a drill intersection of 0.26 ounces over 7.4 feet.

In the shaft, the dump door on the 900' level and the bulkhead below the 1450' level were removed. Installation of ladders and landings were completed from the 900' level to the 1600' level. An electric pump was installed on the 1600' level and development of this new level is scheduled to start in the first week in February.

General - On December 7th, a cost-aid cheque was received in the amount of \$37,757.84 representing and the balance due for the year 1952.
